Van's Aircraft has teamed up with multiple universities on research projects related to the RV-12. We are looking for flight data from customers (preferably with a SkyView). Please send in your flight data by going into the setup menu SYSTEM SOFTWARE>EXPORT USER DATA LOGS> and exporting the data to a USB drive. (See the link below for easy to follow instructions!) The file may be large. Zipping the file will reduce the file size below 10MB. Email your flight data files to engineering@vansaircraft.com

We'd love to receive data for as many flights as you're willing to send. The more data we have, the more accurate we can be with our research projects.

In order to get the most concise data, it's best that you clear the previous flight's data from the Skyview unit before each flight. On Skyview equipped aircraft this is a simple and quick process. To clear the flight data inside the setup menu go to SYSTEM SETUP>DATA LOG SETUP>CLEAR ALL DATA then select the "CLEAR" button in the lower right.

See the simple instructions below. This covers both clearing data and exporting data to a thumb drive. It's very easy and quick and we could really use the data!

Van's will keep all data confidential and is not concerned with which aircraft generated the data. Feel free to remove any references to a specific aircraft.

RV-12 FLIGHT DATA DOWNLOAD

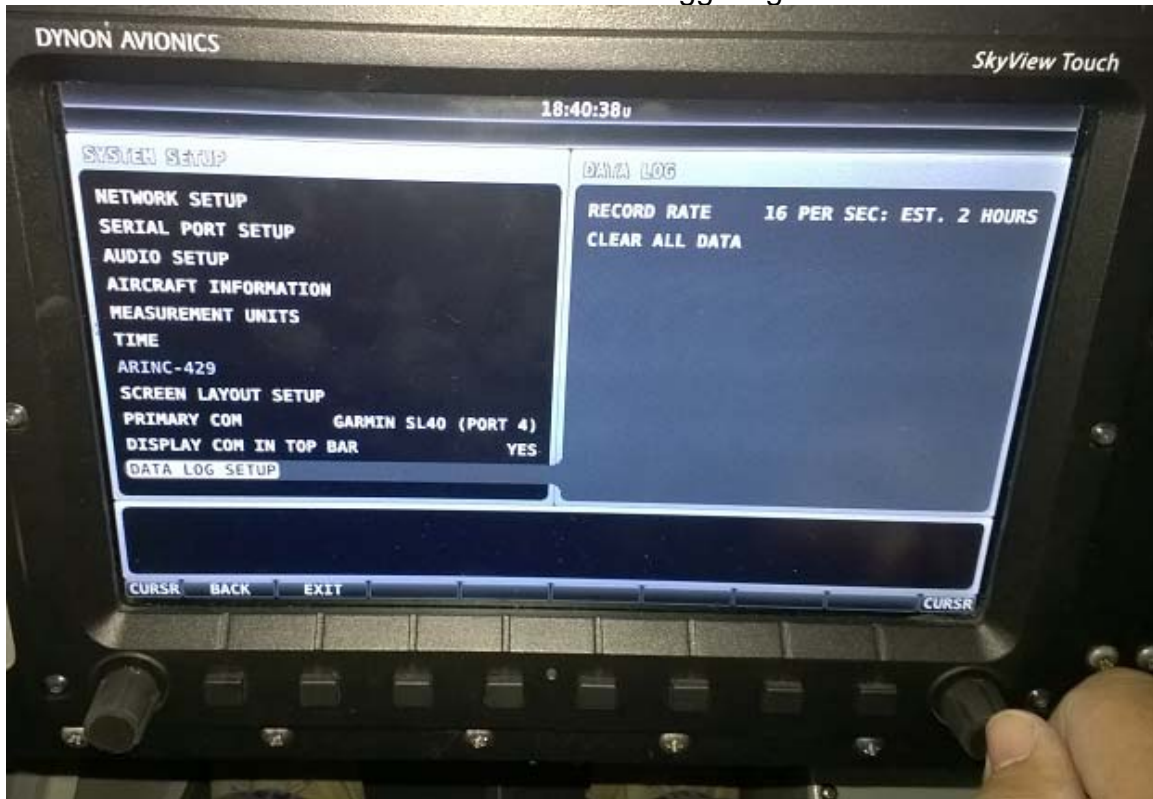
STEP 1: Before flight enter setup menu by holding hard keys 7 and 8.



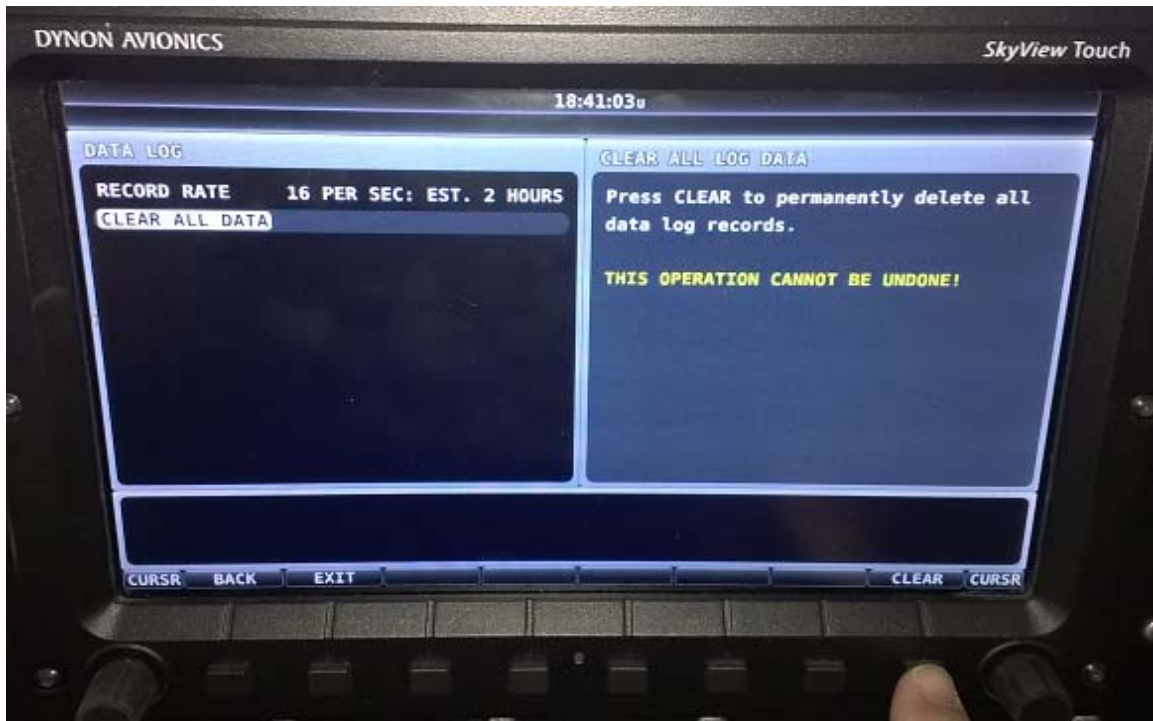
STEP 2: Select "SYSTEM SETUP" and toggle right.



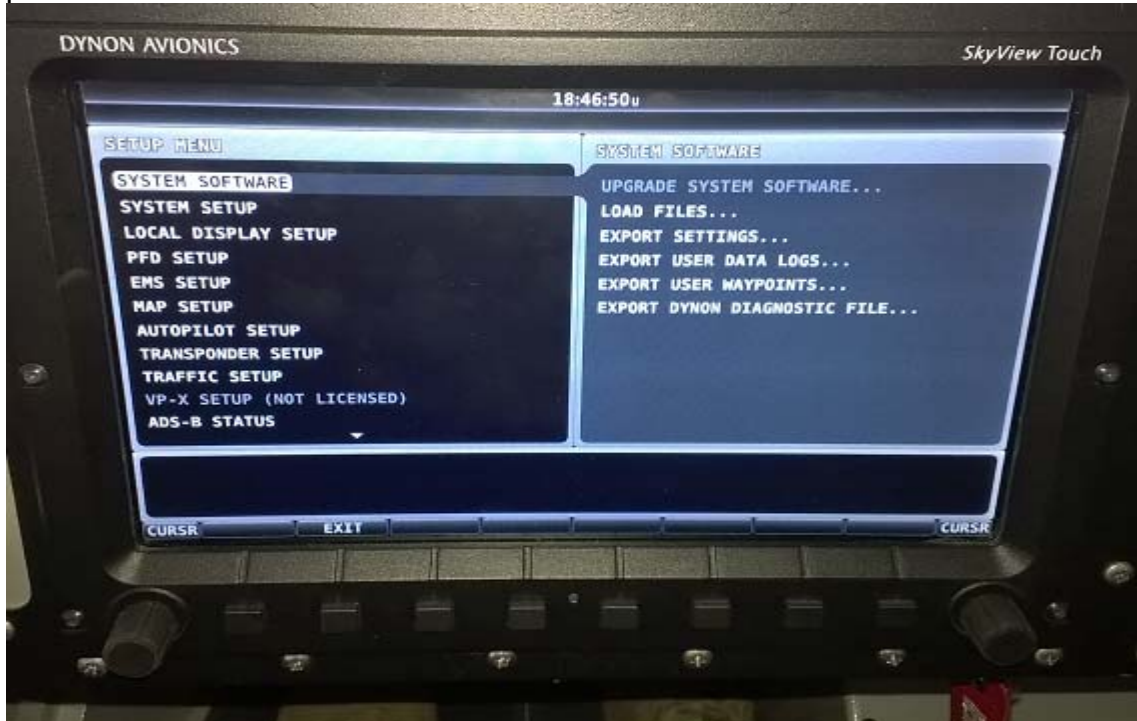
STEP 3: Scroll down to "DATA LOG SETUP" toggle right.



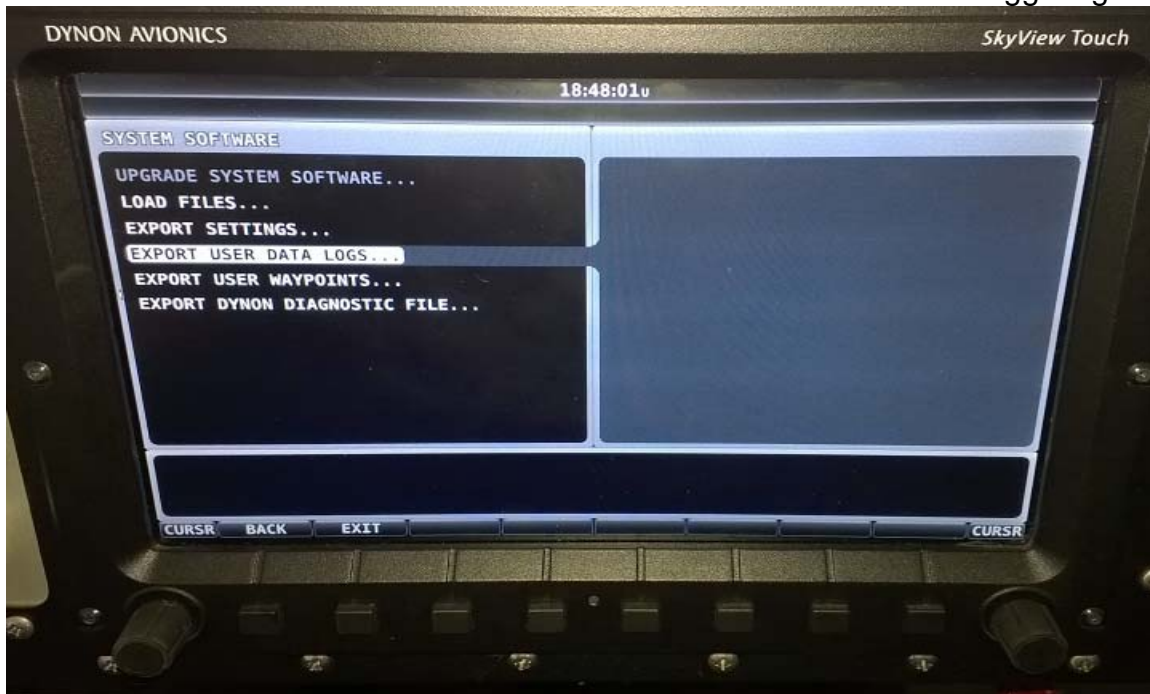
STEP 4: Scroll down to "CLEAR ALL DATA" and push hard key 8 to clear. After you clear the flight data push hard key 2/EXIT to get back to normal Dynon flight screens.



STEP 5: After your flight repeat step 1 and select “SYSTEM SOFTWARE” and toggle right. To be able to select “SYSTEM SOFTWARE” you must have a thumb drive in the USB port or it will not be active to select as shown in the second picture.



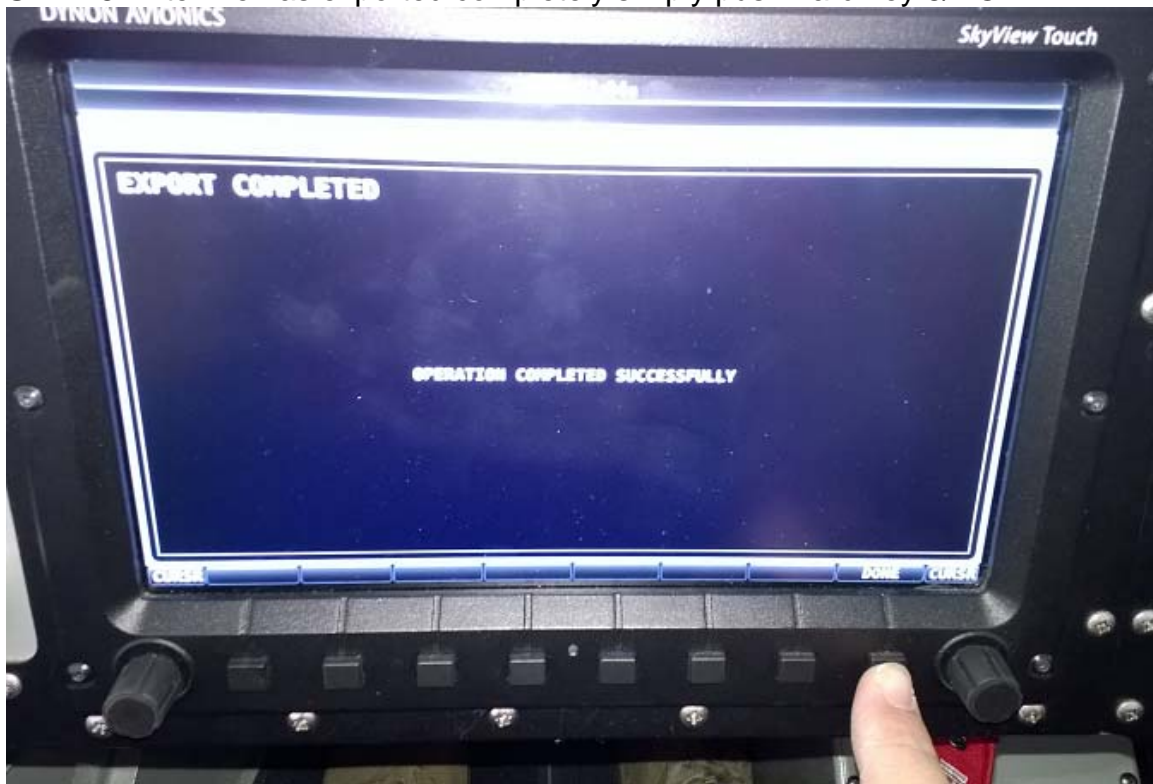
STEP 6: Scroll down and select “EXPORT USER DATA LOGS” and toggle right.



STEP 7: At this point it will allow you to add a file name before exporting. Chose a file name or pilots name, this file will automatically have N number and date. After you add a file name push hard key 8/EXPORT and wait for file to export.



STEP 8: After file has exported completely simply push hard key 8/DONE



STEP 9: Push hard key 2/EXIT to get back to normal Dynon flight screens.
