**Synopsis:** Sensenich propellers with the white pitch cylinder shipped in RV-12 Powerplant kits, or installed on S-LSA RV-12, aircraft are affected by the above Sensenich SB.

## **Method of Compliance:**

<u>Step 1</u>: Determine if your propeller is affected by the Sensenich SB. Propellers shipped after July 2014 from Vans should not be affected.

<u>Step 2:</u> If affected, inspect in accordance with Sensenich SB2016-06B1. Refer to RV-12 KAI Section 47 for spinner and propeller installation details.

<u>Step 3:</u> Make a logbook entry indicating compliance with Van's Aircraft SB 18-07-05 REV 1.
